## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 27, 2013, the Court entered a Notice of Intention to Dismiss (doc. 58), directing Plaintiff to file a return of service on defendants Denise Tomlinson, Dorothy Hyatt, Michelle McCaulley, Kate Rugroden, Leslie Sturges, and John Does 1-10 ("the new defendants"). The Court observed that the new defendants had not been served within the 120-day window prescribed by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m). On July 2, the Court extended Plaintiff's deadline to file proof of service on the new defendants to July 19. The Court warned Plaintiff that failure to timely file proof of service would result in the dismissal of her claims against the new defendants.

Since that time, Plaintiff has filed proof of service on defendants Hyatt and Rugroden (doc. 65). She has not, however, filed proof of service on the other new defendants. Accordingly, all claims in the above-styled and -numbered cause against defendants Denise Tomlinson, Michelle McCaulley, Leslie Sturges, and John Does 1-10 are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
