NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS:

AMENDED MOTION TO QUASH MODIFY SUBPOENA, PROTECTIVE ORDER.

The cause is called for hearing.

The matter is argued and submitted.

LATER, the Court rules as follows:

The Court has considered that papers filed August 25, 2016 as a reply by Ms. Cummins. Ms. Cummins is admonished that her failure to pick up papers as the designated location for prolonged periods will no longer be accepted as an excuse for late filings.

Ms. Cummins failed to meet and confer prior to filing this motion in violation of CCP Section 2031.060(a). That failure constitutes grounds for denial of this motion.

The motion should also be denied on the merits. The records submitted with plaintiff's opposition were not "stolen," as Ms. Cummins insists. Ms. Cummins has misrepresented the Texas Court's Protective Order signed April 1, 2016, which specifically permits plaintiff to use the First Bank records in this action. These records, in turn, strongly suggest that Ms. Cummins has not been truthful with the Court on matters relating to her assets, the bank accounts over which she has signature authority, and her relation-

ship to Animal Advocates. There is an appropriate basis for plaintiff to obtain the records in the six subpoenas at issue.

Plaintiff is admonished that submission of unredacted records containing Ms. Cummin's SSAN and Paypal account records, and the bank account and routing numbers for Animal Advocates, is unacceptable. Plaintiff shall forthwith take steps to seal the offending documents, and/or to substitute redacted copies, including submission of any necessary order. Further violation of CRC 1.120(b) will subject offending party to monetary sanctions.
