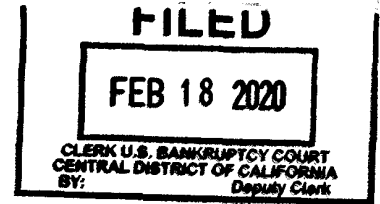

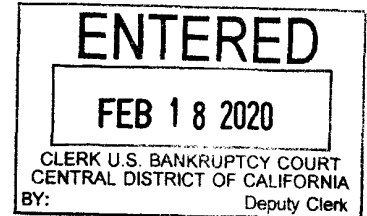


Order on the Application to Have the Appellate Filing Fee Waived
