

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On February 12, 2019, the Motion of Plaintiff Konstantin Khionidi, as Trustee of the Cobbs Trust, to Compel The Deposition of Mary Cummins-Cobb came on regularly for a hearing. Plaintiff was represented by Philip H. Stillman and Stillman & Associates and Defendant Mary Cummins-Cobb ("Defendant") appeared in pro per. - 3. Defendant can privately videotape the deposition, provided that (a) any videocamera capture both counsel and the deponent in a manner consistent with Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(5)(B), (b) the private videotape or any transcript made from the private videotape shall not be an official record of the deposition and may not be used as a record of the deposition in any proceedings and (c) if defendant chooses to videotape the proceedings, (i) she may not use the videotape for any purpose, (ii) Defendant may not disseminate or cause the videotape or a transcript made from her videotape or any copies of the videotape, either publicly or privately to any third person, website, blog, internet site, email, DVD, or any other mode of transmission, without a prior order from this Court upon noticed Motion.
- 4. Neither Plaintiff nor Defendant may not disseminate or cause any videotape of the deposition of Defendant or a transcript made from any videotape or any copies of the videotape, either publicly or privately to any third person, website, blog, internet site, email, DVD, or any other mode of transmission, without a prior order from this Court upon noticed Motion.
